Métro on Beechwood has been bought by Metro Inc.

Main and Main Property on 2 Selkirk, has been sold with new investors added.

Multiuse pathway will be maintained from Montreal Rd to Odawa Bridge next Winter.

City is reviewing Transportation Plan. Early March expect Rideau-Rockliffe community session. On North River VCA is finalizing its comments/changes for the road design following discussion in the SDT committee.

Q- Will transfer of trucks to Coventry increase circulation in Vanier? How can we prevent that the crisis will be moved within our community? Vanier Parkway: trucks not allowed but that is not implemented. What is Biker's Church's implication?

A- Coventry was provided and negotiated by City for trucks and the Confederation Park shed. There is a fundamental disagreement between councillors and police about the use of vehicules. No policing.

Bikers' Church – please report to the City and Ottawa Police if you are witnessing such activity.

Backlash: lack of confidence in police services.

Q- Opening of Palace Street as main entrance and 37 stories planned (City has permitted to double the height stated by regulations): that does not reflect public's wish and City regulations.

A- please reengage with Mathieu. The height will be discussed at next meeting. It should have a proper entrance such as Meilleur Private.

Q- Was a permit issued to protestors? Why is the army not called to end the protest?

A- i.e. Panda Game need permit for party on Russell; crisis management examples in France, Argentina. Consequences are expected if permit not issued. This is more than a municipal matter now. The Canadian Army does not have the same training and stature as American National Guard.

Q- Are we to expect another convoy this week-end?

A- A convoy from Western Canada is on the hill. Other groups have joined. Weekend warriors are more from the region, and can be expected as long as there is an occupation on Wellington. Other folks driving to Quebec City, Windsor Bridge and Toronto.

Q- Who can protect us and assure us that the problem won't be displaced to Vanier?

If OPS doesn't want to do the job, which other level can step up?

A- The current chief reports the involvement of provincial solicitor.

The province is the only institution which can ask for military intervention. Ottawa

can be put in guardianship. Confusion because Ottawa is a capital. A- I am trying to develop an emergency plan but the City is not collaborating with this project.
