Last Thursday, City budget presented:

11,000,000 cuts in transit services. Fare increases expected, Dec. is free. Routes 17, 15, 55, 19, 56 were cut in Vanier last June. Plus impact of R1 taking from local routes, more than 50% cuts in Vanier. R1 was supposed to be temporary due to the pandemic but it was it will become permanent in the new budget.

Housing: 38 millions spent last year. Only 15 millions approved this year.
