-The City will consult residents on Marquette, Cercle Michel, Lebrun et Ste-Monique – regarding upcoming road reconstruction.

Tabor Parquette: stairs must be modified according to contract. The City must secure the land before reinstalling the stairs. A temporary pedestrian connection thru the ramp will be accessible in the following weeks.

Riverain Park: construction of second phase ongoing: skate park, baseball. In a few weeks, water access.

Carillon Park modernization : public consultation coming up.

Carleton U Architectural Students will review the possibility of an indoor pool at Richelieu Centre and a formal gym.

Assumption Catholic School and City study a potential partnership for a community centre and studio on 2 large lots. 2 primary school gyms could be used as well.

Q- Parquette Tabor/St-Denis: is the whole structure unstable? People jump the fence, houses are being built around it.

A- The city engineers discovered that the Tabor stairs are not sturdily attached- but rather, built on fill, which is potentially unstable.

A replacement staircase is promised.

Q-trees- it can be costly to maintain large old trees on private property. Is any municipal help available?

A- bylaw says property owners are responsible for their trees. There's a new bylaw since Jan - which imposes heavy penalties and requires replacement etc. goal to protect trees. No quick answer. A study was done in Westboro (which is similar to sandy hill) which found they lost 50% of their tree cover- Vanier is at a similar risk.

Q- Riverain Park – washrooms needed, or at least portable ones, while we wait for the facility to be built?

A- Please write a formal request to MF.

Q- Slanting sidewalks : not appreciated by residents.

A- Benefits are better for Winter. Elizabeth Lang at City. MF would support residents' complaints. VCA will follow up.
